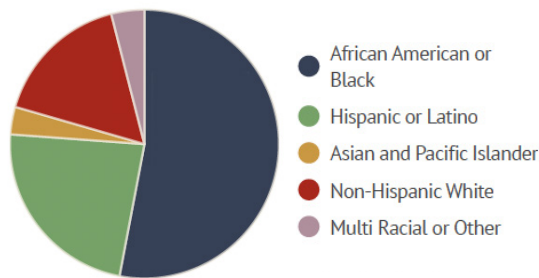

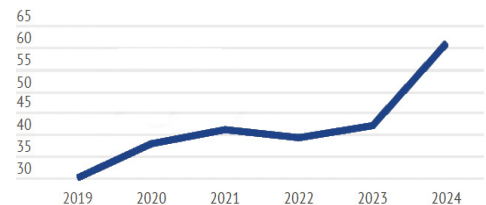

Youth Shooting Victims by Race/Ethnicity

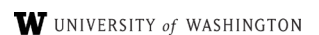


Number of Youth Shooting Victims Age 0-17
